



Jubilee's School of Higher Learning



Jubilee's School of Higher Learning will open September 9th, 2010. JSOHL is affiliated with Christian Life Educators Network, of Columbus, GA. Certificates, diplomas and degrees may be obtained by taking courses and accumulating units.

Successful completion, for example, of one course earns 3 units. Students must maintain a GPA of a 2.0 [C] and higher in order to receive a Certificate [15 units], the Diploma of Theology [30 units], and the Associate of Theology [60 units], or the Bachelor of Theology [126 units].

Students must maintain a GPA of 3.0 [B] or higher in order to receive the Master of Theology [171 units], the Master of Sacred Studies [216 units], the Doctor of Sacred Studies [261 units], or the Doctor of Theology [300 units].

The course content has six divisions of study for the Bachelor of Theology through Doctor of Theology degrees. These divisions are: Biblical Theology, Christian Counseling, Historical Theology, New Testament, Old Testament, and Practical Theology.

JSOHL opens September 9th with the first course offered: "Journey into Wholeness," taught by Rev. Don Crossland. This course will be completed through a concentration of 3 hours both Thursday and Friday nights, and 4 hours on Saturday. At the completion of the course, tests will be taken and submitted to C.L.E.N. for grading.

October's course, held October 7-9, will be "The Prophetic Church," taught by Dr. Ian Bond.

November's course, held November 4-6, will be "Training for Reigning," taught by Dr. Ron Cottle.

December's course, held December 2-4, will be "The Book of Galatians," taught by Dr. Ron Cottle.

Courses to be held in 2011 will be announced by December of this year.

Advanced placement credits may be given based on prior education and ministry experience. Applications may be submitted to C.L.E.N., along with registration forms. Dr. Ron Cottle will then assess what credits are to be given, if any.
